

Lesson Plan KS2



ART & DESIGN - Tell Your Story

Lesson Objective

To improve mastery of art and design techniques.

Starter	Main Teaching	Resources
<u>This can be linked to the Geography Lesson Plan.</u> <u>Note taking with drawings:</u> What were your favourite features of SMSG Church or of Stony Stratford? Take suggestions and show children how to use quick drawings to 'note take', e.g. a musical note to represent the organ or a slice of bread to represent the bakery.	<u>Activity 1 - Top 5</u> Individually, children 'note take' with drawings, their 5 favourite features of SMSG Church or places in Stony Stratford. Label them 1 to 5 from most to least favourite to them and share why they chose number 1. <u>Activity 2 - Abstract that!</u> How could you tell the story of your visit to Stony Stratford using those five features/places? Show children a variety of images of abstract drawings of London. Pictures 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. For each, discuss: What is the artist's favourite place in London? What are the artist's feelings about London? What sort of day did they have there? Busy/relaxed/wet/sunny. What technique has the artist used and why? Is there anything else you learn from the artist's day in London and how? <u>Activity 3 - Sketch it!</u> Show an abstract drawing of Stony Stratford, Picture 7. What techniques could you apply or adaptations could you make to this picture to convey your feelings and experience of Stony Stratford and SMSG Church? Children then sketch and redraft their own designs for their picture and plan what medium they will use. <u>Activity 4 - Tell your Story</u> Children produce their final picture of their visit to SMSG Church/Stony Stratford. Share finished work. The class express how the picture makes them feel and what they think stands out and why.
