

Lesson Plan KS1



COMPUTING - Chronological Order

Lesson Objective:

To produce a flow chart for real events.

Starter	Main Teaching	Resources
Show some pictures on the interactive white board of the children's visit to SMSG Church, to remind the children of their visit. Talk about what happened and the main points of the day e.g. Leaving school, travelling to SMSG Church, arriving, hearing the Organ, etc. This lesson can be used in conjunction with English - The day I saw an organ!	<u>Activity 1 - ORGANise it!</u> As a class, organise the facts/events into a chronological order or use the information gathered from the English lesson 'The Day I saw an organ!', together with time connectives and actions! <u>Activity 2 - Telling the story</u> Give the children some examples of flow charts, to show how we are led through the chart. Create a flow chart of the visit day as a class on the board with the children suggesting the order, phrases and graphics. <u>Activity 3 - Try it yourself</u> Let the children experiment themselves individually or in pairs. <u>Activity 4 - Finished product</u> Refine and add pictures, if appropriate.	Interactive whiteboard or events/facts could be written on large cardboard. There are many examples of flow chart creations on the Internet.
