The Willis Pipe Organ is set in an historical building within an historical town! There are many documents charting the history of Stony Stratford and Calverton and all that lies within Milton Keynes and the neighbouring area of South Northants. Internet websites, local books and guides abound, e.g. <http://www.stonystratford.co.uk/Documents/Stony%20Stratford%20Walks.pdf>. Stony Stratford and the neighbouring village of Calverton have very long histories from pre-historic travellers through the Roman and Medieval periods to the present day.

The Church of St Mary and St Giles is very much part of that landscape and the oldest part still remaining dates back to 1487. We have a brief history of SMSG Church leaflet available in the building at all times, together with a detailed history of the Willis pipe organ.

The geographical landscape of the area has many interesting features, both physical and human. There is a wealth of information, both on and offline to enhance geographical study in all its forms.
