LANGUAGES - How many pipes?

Lesson Objective: To learn to count with confidence using the organ pipes

Starter	Main Teaching	Resources
Show the children the Resource picture 'How many organ pipes?' Where have they seen these before?	<u>Activity 1 - 1 to 10</u> Teach the class the number names in a foreign language, using 1 to 10 initially, pointing at each pipe in turn and saying the number and have them repeat it back. When the children are confident, just point to the numbers and they give the name. <u>Activity 2 - Be an organ pipe</u> Number the children from 1 to 10 around the class. When their number is called out they have to stand up straight like an organ pipe. <u>Activity 3 - Mix it up</u> Point to alternate pipes and have the children say the numbers. Get the children to stand up when you mix the numbers up. Count down, from 10 to 1. <u>Activity 4 - Counting with confidence</u> Can the children count in order when the picture is removed? Can they put themselves into groups of the numbers the teacher calls out. When really confident, teach the vocabulary for all the numbers up to 21.	Organ Pipe picture.
