A varied music programme

We want the newly restored Willis Pipe organ in St Mary and St Giles (SMSG) to be used and enjoyed as widely as possible - and we need to raise funds to keep it in good condition. We do this through our Music for All @ SMSG programme of pipe organ and other events, including:



Willis Pipe Organ Festival each September as part of Heritage Open Days, and regular Organ Recitals.

Concerts from cello to chamber choir, guitar to piano and voice, organ and orchestra.

Come & Sing day in November, open to all, to learn a short work and perform it informally.

Drop-in events – each Third Thursday at Twelve Thirty there's a free short session of live music in good company, and in winter free monthly Saturday Musical Bite coffee mornings.



Outreach – the Church Band and Handbell Ringers entertain local people in care homes, community groups and other churches.

Education Programme so that visiting school, youth and community groups can find out about pipe organs.

Access Programme so that organ scholars and others can learn and practise on our Willis.



A venue open to all

Local groups are welcome to use the church as a venue for concerts and events, making use of the pipe organ and grand piano.

The building has a wonderful acoustic for music-making.
