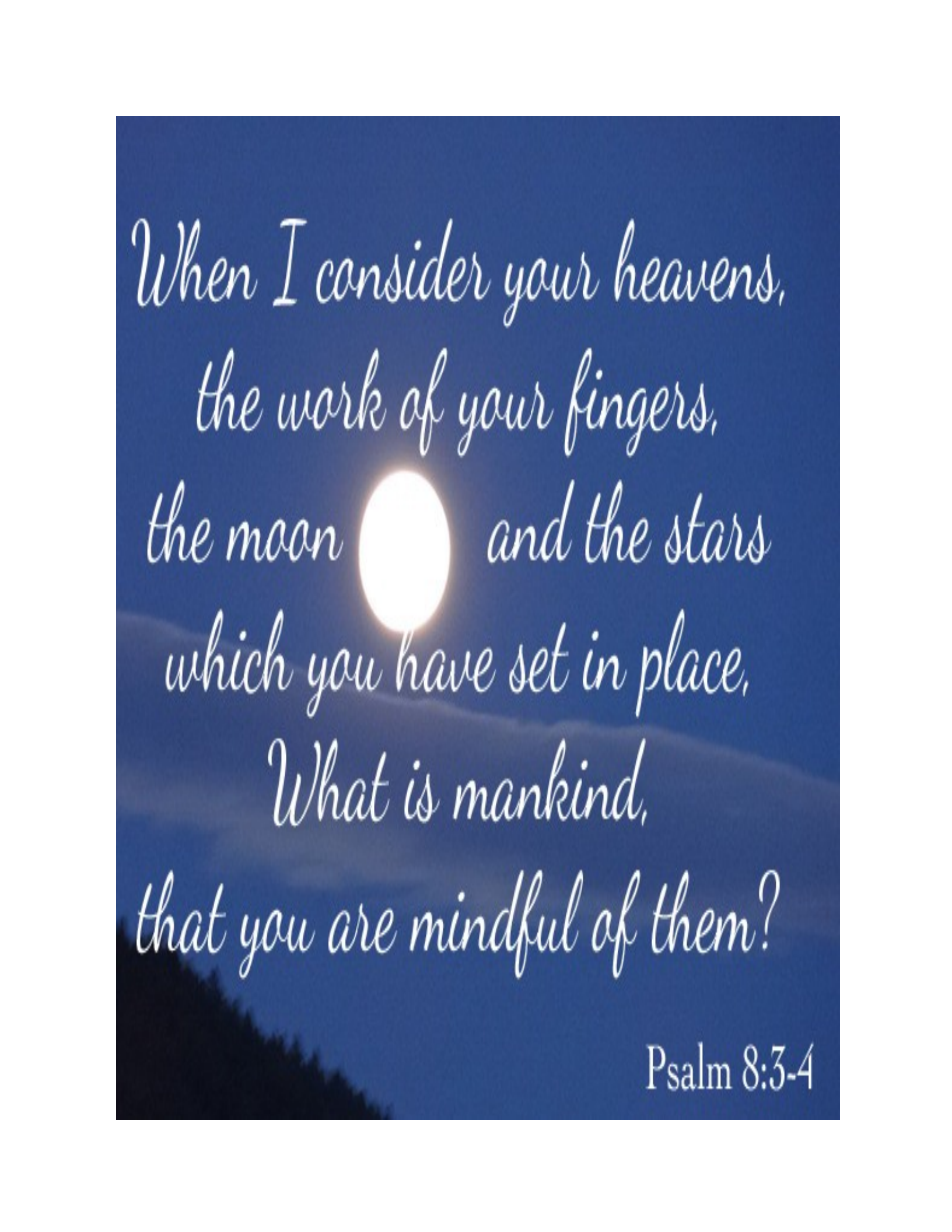


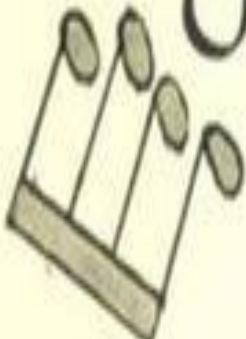


*When I consider your heavens,
