## **MUSIC** - Baby Grand Piano

Visit Objective: To discover how the piano produces sound and to see inside as this happens. To experience hearing, feeling and making that sound.

Starter	Main Teaching	Resources
The group starts by singing together a known song with the piano accompaniment.	Activity 1 - Let's have a peep!  Visitors are shown the inside of the grand piano and have a question and answer session about how the sound is made, discussing the length of the strings, materials used and what the pedals are used for.	This session is led by members of the Music for All @ SMSG Visits Team.

Activity 2 - Vibrations Visitors are given the opportunity to make sounds by 'playing' the strings and describing the sensation of touching a string when the keyboard is played.  Activity 3 - Be the pianist At this point in the session visitors have the chance to play a piece of known music, a note or a chord.  Activity 4 - Listen closely The pianist plays a variety of piano excerpts. The visitors listen and respond, commenting on the way the piano is played and the feeling evoked from this.
